Do not give to children under 12 years old unless your doctor tells you to.

DO NOT EXCEED THE STATED DOSE. If symptoms persist for more than 7 days consult a doctor.

Do not take if allergic to any of the ingredients, have heart, liver or kidney disease, or breathing difficulty or suffer from alcoholism or raised pressure in the head.

ethanol, sucrose.
Sucrose 1.4g per 5ml, alcohol 22 vol%.

This medicine contains opium tincture, which reduces the desire to cough, and squill oxymel to help remove phlegm.

1. Before you use this medicine
Do not use the medicine if you have....

- An allergy to any of the ingredients listed in section 3.
- Heart problems.
- Liver or kidney disease.
- Shallow breath or breathing difficulties.
- A head injury or persistent headache.
- An asthma attack.
- Taken MAOIs (monoamine oxidase inhibitors) for depression within the last two weeks.
- Alcoholism.

Talk to your doctor or pharmacist if you have....

- An under-active thyroid • An adrenal hormone imbalance • Bowel problems or blockage
- Prostate trouble • Muscle weakness • Shock
- Low blood pressure • General tiredness • Or you are elderly, as elderly people can react differently to the medicine.

Talk to your doctor or pharmacist if you are taking....

- Metoclopramide or domperidone for nausea and sickness
- Mexiletine for irregular heartbeat • Tranquillisers, antidepressants, sedatives or sleeping tablets
- Spironolactone or other water tablets for fluid retention • Steroids • Amphotericin for fungal infections • Rifampicin for tuberculosis • Antacids
- Carbenoxolone for stomach ulcers
- Propranolol for stomach spasms and incontinence • Sodium polystyrene sulphonate for excessive levels of potassium in the blood
- Phenobarbital for epilepsy.

Pregnant or breastfeeding....
Ask your doctor or pharmacist for advice before using this medicine if you are pregnant, might be pregnant or are breastfeeding. Gee's Linctus should not be used in pregnancy unless the doctor has told you to do so.

Driving and using machines....
This medicine may cause drowsiness. If you are affected do not drive or operate machinery. The medicine can affect your ability to drive as it may make you sleepy or dizzy.

- Do not drive while taking this medicine until you know how it affects you.
- It is an offence to drive if this medicine affects your ability to drive.
- However, you would not be committing an offence if:
 - The medicine has been prescribed to treat a medical or dental problem and
 - You have taken it according to the instructions given by the prescriber or in the information provided with the medicine and
 - It was not affecting your ability to drive safely.

Talk to your doctor or pharmacist if you are not sure whether it is safe for you to drive while taking this medicine.

Important ingredient information
• This product contains 1.4g of sucrose per 5ml. This should be taken into account in people with diabetes. If you have been told by your doctor that you have an intolerance to some sugars, contact your doctor before taking this medicine • It also contains 22 vol% ethanol (alcohol), i.e. up to 869 mg per dose, equivalent to 22ml of beer or 9ml of wine per dose. Harmful for those suffering from alcoholism. To be taken into account in pregnant or breastfeeding women, children and high-risk groups such as people with liver disease or epilepsy. The amount of alcohol in this medicinal product may alter the effects of other medicines.

2. Possible side effects
Like all medicines, Gee's Linctus can have side effects, although these don't affect everyone.
Possible side effects are:

- Nausea • Sickness • Constipation • Drowsiness • Confusion
- Loss of appetite • Diarrhoea • Stomach pain • Shortage of breath • Difficulty in urinating • Skin itching and flushing
- Rash • Low blood pressure • Prolonged use may lead to tolerance (the medicine loses its effect) and dependence. If you notice these or any other side effects, stop use and tell your doctor or pharmacist. They will tell you what to do.

Reporting of side effects
If you get any side effects, talk to your doctor, pharmacist or nurse. This includes any possible side effects not listed in this leaflet. You can also report side effects directly via the Yellow Card Scheme at: www.mhra.gov.uk/yellowcard
By reporting side effects you can help provide more information on the safety of this medicine.

3. Further information
If you accidentally take too much see a doctor straight away. Take the pack with you to show which medicine you have swallowed.

- Do not use after the expiry date. The expiry date refers to the last day of that month.
- Return any unused medicine to the pharmacy for disposal.

The active ingredients per 5ml are: opium tincture 0.083 ml, squill oxymel 1.667 ml.
The other ingredients are: benzoic acid (E210), anise oil, camphor, ethanol, cinnamic acid, cinnamon oil, ethyl cinnamate, vanillin, sucrose and purified water.

What the medicine looks like
Gee's Linctus is a brown cloudy liquid. It is supplied in 200ml bottles.

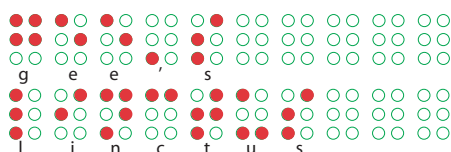
